## FEI JUMP DEFINITIONS:

### One Round Stakes- 1 round

Jump a clear round in quickest time. Point penalties for refusals, knocked jumps, time faults

### Am7 – 2 rounds

One round of course, to be followed by second round of jump off course, for any competitor who has completed a clear round. The competitor must remain in the ring if the first round is clear, as after passing between the finish flags the competitor will be given a bell to indicate they have 30 seconds to start the “jump off” course

### Six Bar Competition 1 round

In this competition, six vertical obstacles are placed in a straight line about 11m apart from each other. They must be identically constructed and composed only of poles of the same type. The number of obstacles may be reduced depending on the size of the arena.

3.2. All the obstacles may be kept at the same height, for example 1.0m or at progressive heights, for example 80cm, 90cm, 1m, 1.10m, 1.20m, 1.30m or the first two at 90cm, the next two at 1m, and so on.

3.3. In the event of a refusal or a run-out, the competitor must restart the course at the obstacle where the fault was made, but he is allowed to make his approach from outside the space between the two poles. He may thus take the obstacle at an angle.

3.4. The first jump-off must take place over the six obstacles which must be raised unless the competitors who are equal for first place have been penalised in the first round. From the second jump-off onwards, the number of obstacles may be reduced to three but the distance between them must be kept at about 11m as required initially (the lower obstacles should be withdrawn).

- a. \$10 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member\* of EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. \*Must produce proof.
- b. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the [Day Participant Waiver](#).

*PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV Rules may be left uninsured.*

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
3. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
4. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
5. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
6. No stallions, colts or rigs.
7. Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers.
8. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
9. PCAV Lungeing Policy applies.
10. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any
